

What is a professional appraisal?

A professional appraisal is a written statement, independently, impartially and objectively prepared by a qualified professional independent jewelry appraiser, setting forth an opinion of the defined value of an adequately described piece of jewelry as of a specific date, supported by the presentation and analysis of relative jewelry market information.

Why do you need an appraisal?

Appraisals are often the core negotiating tool in a range of legal proceedings and court cases. A well-supported written appraisal, by an appraiser with the appropriate credentials and experience, is critical for success in estate, divorce, bankruptcy and insurance settlements.
